As you are aware that Rajasthan Skill Livelihoods Development Corporation (RSLDC) is conducting various Skill Development Programmes and is designated as a Nodal Agency for conducting skill related programs of various Ministries of Central and State Government in the Rajasthan State. RSLDC has perpetually achieved various milestones such as skill award for best state in skilling, Skotch award, etc. Rajasthan has an existence in "Hunar" and RSLDC has major contribution towards making skilled Rajasthan.

WorldSkills India is an initiative of the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, GoI which has been leading the country's participation at WorldSkills International competitions since 2011. NSDC follows a 3-tier selection process, i.e. regional, national and final selection. The winners from the regional competitions will participate at national competition, where two candidates will be selected in each category. These candidates will undergo training for 5-6 months, before they compete at final competition. The winner at the final competition will represent India at WorldSkills Competition to be held in Shanghai, China in September, 2026.

We are pleased to inform you that RSLDC is all set to participate in the India Skills Competition 2025. Rajasthan State needs to organize the competition on two levels i.e.

1. Competition on the District/Zonal Level.
2. Competition on the State Level.

**Key Details of India Skills Competition 2025:**

1. Registration Portal Link: <https://www.skillindiadigital.gov.in/india-skills-2025>
2. Participation: Open to all youth aged 16-25 years (born on or after January 1, 2004; for select advanced technology skills, born on or after January 1, 2001)
3. Competition Tracks: State-level by RSLDC and Sector Skill Council (SSCs) for other skills
4. Last Date to Register: September 30, 2025
5. Skill Categories: 63 skill areas across engineering, IT, construction, creative arts, hospitality, manufacturing, logistics, etc. (List Attached)

**Action Requested:**

1. All affiliated institutions (Polytechnic Colleges, Engineering Colleges, ITIs, Hotel Management Institute, Nursing Collages, Short Term Training centres and any other source of potential candidates for list of skills attached) may be directed to immediately display the SIDH registration link and India Skills 2025 competition details at prominent and visible locations, including notice boards, seminar halls, departmental offices, canteens, libraries, computer laboratories, and entry gates, where students can access and register.
2. Institutions should conduct awareness sessions and encourage eligible students to register for the competition through SIDH portal (<https://www.skillindiadigital.gov.in/india-skills-2025>) before the closing date. Guidance for registration should be provided to interested students.


