

About the Department

The Centre for Mass Communication, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur came into being in 1991. So far, more than 1200 students have studied and passed out from the Centre and a large number of them are working in different spheres of Media. In 1991-92 under the self-financing scheme the Centre started a one year P.G diploma course in Journalism. This was later converted into a one year Bachelor Degree Course in Journalism and Mass Communication (BJMC) in 1992-93. From the academic session 2001-02 it has been replaced by a two-year (four Semester) Master's Degree Programme.

Presently Prof. Urvashi Sharma is heading the department.
